

Request for poster abstracts

Poster abstract submissions are invited for the 16th National Conference of the Primary Care Diabetes Society (PCDS), which will be staged virtually on 5 and 6 November.

This year will feature the return of our annual poster exhibition, which will be hosted virtually. Posters should provide examples of good practice or innovation in diabetes care within the primary care setting, highlighting work that is of relevance and, ideally, practical significance to other primary care teams. The PCDS Committee will judge accepted posters during the conference, and an award will be presented for the entry that reflects the best contribution to diabetes care within the primary care setting.

Entries must be made electronically by 17.30 on 11 September 2020.
